

# WINTER CAMP PACKING LIST

## WHAT TO BRING:

Bible (hardcopy), sleeping bag or bedding, pillow/pillowcase, blanket, towels/washcloths, toiletries, water bottle, sweatshirts/jackets, sports clothes, warm clothes, snow clothes, boots, gloves, sneakers, flashlight. *Any additional questions on what to bring, feel free to contact a youth leader.*

**\*\*\*Please have campers bags labeled for easy identification while unpacking\*\*\***

## WHAT NOT TO BRING:

Expensive clothing or jewelry, pocket knives, matches, lighters, fireworks, computer/video games, drugs, alcohol. E-cigarettes, vapes, or any form of tobacco products, or animals of any kind. **DO NOT BRING YOUR CELL PHONES.**

**CAMPER DRESS:** *in striving to maintain modesty, please use the following dress guidelines...*

### **Both:**

Please bring modest and appropriate clothes to camp. Avoid clothing with any inappropriate advertising. Also keep in mind to bring clothes that are not too nice as they may get dirty. As youth leaders, we reserve the right to request a change in clothing deemed inappropriate. Any questions ask youth leader **before** wearing it.

### **Girls:**

Recreational Dress - Modest sweatpants, leggings, jeans, or hand width above the knee length or longer shorts. Modest, loose-fitting tops (no midriff). No tank tops or sleeveless shirts of any kind. *(as leaders we have the right to request a change in clothing any time)*

### **Guys:**

Recreational Dress - Loose-fitting, hand width above the knee or longer shorts, or loose-fitting pants. No muscle shirts of any kind. *(as leaders we have the right to request a change in clothing any time)*

## MEDICATIONS:

All medications must be given to counselor/youth leader upon arrival. This includes vitamins, food supplements, over-the-counter medications, and all prescription medications. Please have all medications in a labeled Ziploc bag with a dosage schedule clearly listed on it. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

## CHRISTIAN CONDUCT:

CCH Youth maintains high standards of conduct and separation. Campers who use tobacco, alcohol or any form of illegal drugs at camp will be sent home. Any campers who are uncooperative or non-compliant are subject to dismissal as well.
